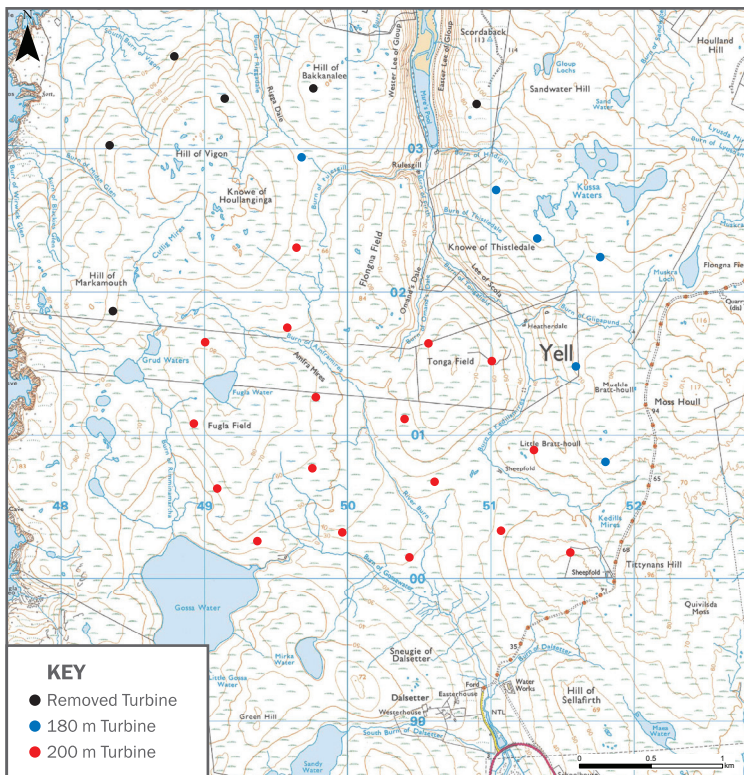


ENERGY ISLES WIND FARM



Energy Isles Limited was founded in 2014 by a consortium of over fifty mainly Shetland-based companies working together to develop a plan for a wind farm in the North of Yell. In 2019, Energy Isles Limited announced a development partnership with Statkraft, a leading international company and Europe's largest generator of renewable energy.

PROJECT EVOLUTION

Energy Isles Wind Farm was first identified in 2012 and the project has evolved following public consultation events in June 2018 and February 2019 and feedback from key statutory consultees on our application. The scheme has been reduced from 29 to 23 turbines following the feedback we received at our last exhibition in February 2019 and we have reduced the height of six turbines from 200m to 180m.

Members of the Energy Isles Wind Farm team will be on hand to answer any questions you may have. We will use the feedback from this exhibition to make our final submission of Supplementary Environmental Information.
